PASTOR'S PAGE



Today's readings speak of gratitude for the healing that occurs by the grace of God, and which asks for our faith. We need to understand the gravity of leprosy at the time of Jesus. Leprosy was a horrible illness, which made man unable to live in the town or city he was from, making him an outcast, one unfit to live

among his fellow men and obliged to live in the wilderness with men of his same condition. It was a real, physical but, above all, an existential problem for the one who suffered from it, affecting his whole life and making him suffer physically, socially, and spiritually. Jesus' healing of these people shows God's mercy and forgiveness towards them. We can certainly apply this condition also to our lives today. Not that we are physically affected by leprosy, but this type of illness could certainly be an image of any suffering that may affect us in many ways.

Christ in this Gospel shows his power to overcome this sickness in these lepers, as an image of his power to address the core of the problem of every human being. This healing, however, requires faith that God
