with God. It causes his praise, ostensibly directed upward toward God, to turn inward toward himself. The Gospel passage tellingly describes how the Pharisee “spoke this prayer to *himself*”. The Pharisee is not speaking to God at all; he is thanking *himself* for his good behavior. According to the Pharisee, it is up to man to keep the law, and every man is exactly what he wants to be. Those who transgress the law deserve contempt. Mercy does not enter this notion of religion, for the Pharisaical man has no need of it: when he speaks of sin, it is that of *others*, not his own.

The second individual, instead, exists before God in the dynamic of the beggar: he knows his deep needfulness and God’s goodness. He has already reached the heart of God, by asking for his mercy. His relationship with God is made of faith and humility. Jesus favors this second attitude. Such a man sees God not merely as the rewarder of the just, but as merciful towards the sinner. His faith emboldens him to enter God’s temple, and his prayer – sincere and contrite – obtains that for which it asks. He goes home justified. *This*, Jesus seems to say, is the true just man: not one who acts justly and despises others, but the one who knows his reality and lean on God’s mercy.

This word calls us to reflect on where we are in this picture: Do I see myself more in the Pharisee or in the tax collector? This word invites our conversion. We can draw courage from the tax collector, and from Jesus’ words: “I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted”.
