PASTOR’S PAGE



The Gospel of today insists once again on the necessity of prayer and Christ tells us that prayer has to be insistent. This account is very simple in its structure and yet very profound. A widow in the society of Jesus’ time had no protection. A widow in Scripture is always the

image of a person in need and whose condition is the one of poverty and precariousness. Here is the first stroke of this Gospel: prayer arises in the one who knows his needs and human poverty. The insistency of prayer is not an exercise of virtue, meaning that I need force myself into prayer and be diligent about it rather, prayer, in its primitive force arises from the fact that if I do not cry out to God, my very existence is at risk. This widow knows her profound need and the risks and perils of her existence; hence her strength to cry out to the Judge to obtain justice.

A second stroke of this Gospel is the deep link between prayer and faith. Faith understood not as an intellectual exercise, but as a profound relationship between persons, and is nourished and enriched by

prayer. We can almost say that without prayer there is no faith in us. Faith is a knowledge that reveals to us the face of God, his essence, his mercy, his justice and patience, and prayer is the instrument through which this knowledge is given to us. A couple that does not speak to each other, that does not communicate, ceases to reveal to each other who they are, even though they think they love each other. It is the same with God: prayer is that moment when we stand before God, stripped of our false images of ourselves, as needy mendicants, where we hear the voice of God telling us that he loves us in our needs and that he has already done justice for us in his son Jesus Christ.
