understanding, involving belief in dogmas. This is faith understood as belief in the doctrine and magisterium of the Church, and it is necessary. Yet faith is more than this. As St. Paul in his Letter to the Hebrews affirms, "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen." Jesus is the hope of mankind, for in Him our liberation becomes possible. So, faith is not only to be in dogma but to have this relationship with Christ, that can grow, as any relationship of love grows, between two persons.

The faith Jesus asks for is faith in Him. Though faith has many facets, possibly the three most important are: belief in Jesus' power to forgive us, no matter how great the sin; faith in his ability to make all things new, no matter how impossible certain situations may be; and finally, faith in Jesus' goodness – which is not so obvious a thing! We all say that God is good in Heaven, that Jesus was a good man: but it takes faith to believe God loves us in our poverty. And yet this is precisely the Good News! That God loves us as we are and has sent his Son, Jesus Christ, to free us.

Finally, faith is a gift from heaven which comes to us and is nourished through the sacraments and through the word. Let us be united to Christ, and he will remain faithful to his word of salvation for each one of us.
