The first reading underlines a theme: “woe to the complacent in Zion, who are not made ill by the collapse of Joseph!” This line in Amos gives us the key to read the Gospel, which presents us with a comparison between the condition of Hell and that of Paradise, the unavoidable outcome of all things.

Our actions, characterized in the present life by the possibility of conversion, nevertheless have an end. Here on earth, thanks to our freedom, we can say yes or no, to the grace of God. We can say no to the plan of God, or submit ourselves to his plan because, we see it as good for our life, or better, we know that God is good and therefore what he has for us is also good. Even, if at the beginning it doesn't seem so good for us.

He who doesn't live in the knowledge that everything has an order, an end, and that all creation is subjected

to God’s good will, lives dissolutely, squandering his life. Living dissolutely means living thoughtlessly, without a goal, without knowing where we’re going. The dissolute man is the one who does not think about the dissolving of all things, and that there is a limit to everything.

In today’s Gospel, the rich man lives his earthly life unconcerned about the result of his actions. One of the first principles of the spiritual life instead, is to see where a given decision of mine will lead me. Thus, the man who is in dialogue with God does not stop simply at the current state of things, but lives with his gaze fixed on heaven, on the eternal things, on the end of all things.

The rich man, instead, having lived a dissolute life, now finds himself frozen in a state of life far from God, and begs Lazarus to warn his brothers. Lazarus reminds the rich man that his brothers already have someone to save them: Moses and the prophets. In other words, Lazarus reminds the rich man of that which he didn’t want to see in his life, that God always offers man a way of salvation.

We too have graces in our lives and help that comes from God. We must learn to value the help God is sending us today and not live thoughtlessly, like dissolute men, unconcerned about our possible ruin. Paradoxically, the final judgement will not consist so much in God asking man for an account, as in man’s realization of how in his freedom he didn’t care to welcome the constant grace of salvation offered by God to help him.
