Every figure in Scripture symbolizes aspects of the spiritual life, which God invites us to make real in our lives. For the second week, the Gospel presents us with a tax collector, this time by name: Zacchaeus. It notes his preeminence among those who steal from their people at the service of the oppressing nation.

Fascinated by Christ, he performs a gesture of great humility: like a child, he runs and climbs a tree in front of his fellow townspeople. Zacchaeus has become deeply interested in Christ, realizing there is something new and different about this man.

Jesus notices Zacchaeus' gesture and responds calling him to get down from the tree and declares before all that he wishes to enter Zacchaeus' house.

Curiously, the Israelites grumble. Their attitude shows they have not understood the Messiah's mission: to show mercy to sinners, to release captives

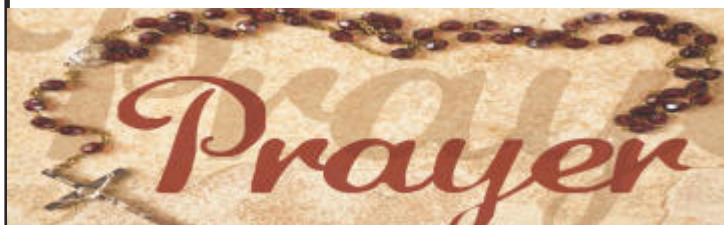

But Zacchaeus stands his ground, tacitly acknowledging before all that he has stolen, he renounces half his wealth, and resolves to make restitution fourfold for his theft. The Lord responds by honoring him even more, declaring him a son of Abraham and announcing that salvation has come to his house.

May Zacchaeus' spiritual insight help us see that Jesus brings something new for all of us. If like Zacchaeus we truly wish to see the Lord, we shall surely gain Christ's attention and he will respond bringing salvation to our house, which is our life.
