PASTOR'S PAGE



Dear Brothers and Sisters, today we have two of our seminarians, John and Daniele here at the Parish to share their experience of Christ and of seminary formation. Please, be generous if the Lord inspires you to help our seminarians in formation.

What can today's Gospel reading, about a first-century Jewish theological dispute have to say to us? Surprisingly, a lot. We also live among men who deny the resurrection. Either not giving much thought to the next life or outright denying it exists; today's Sadducees focus mainly on the world's concerns and affairs. Denying the soul's existence and reducing man to matter, we live in a society that rejects that there could be eternal consequences to how we live on earth. In denying the resurrection, society implicitly promotes a 'this-worldly' mentality, seeking the comforts of the body, the hope of wealth, the desire for human glory.

Jesus' affirmation is a refreshing Good News today. For the resurrection is not 'merely' a reality to be experienced in the next life! Christ comes to resurrect us *now*. Our bodily resurrection will bring to

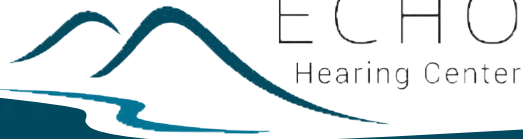

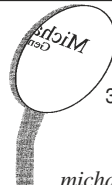
