Dear brothers and sisters,

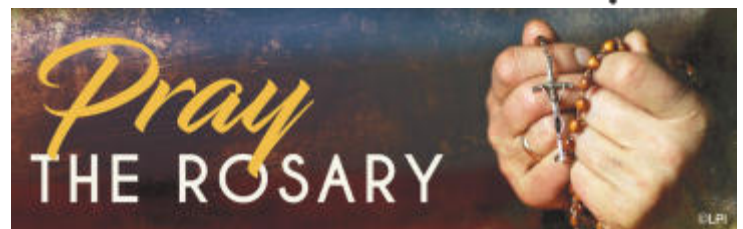
We are in the middle of this Advent season, a beautiful time in which the Church invites us to look at the course of our lives and the end of everything, to discover that what awaits us is the love of God who directs the whole of existence. The end of life is also the engine that moves everything and should be the reason of our existence.

For this reason, I want to invite all of you to our Advent Mission. We are going to have Fr. Armando Marsal coming to speak to us about the virtue of Hope. Fr. Francesco, Fr. Bill and I will be available to hear confessions after his preaching. The Advent Mission is on Tuesday, December 10th at 7:00 pm in the church.

This time also invites us to pray and to be vigilant. For this reason, all are welcome to our morning prayer in the church at 6:00 am, followed by the rosary and by the holy mass at 7:30 am. Confessions are always offered after each Mass, at around 8:00 am.

In the Gospel of today, John the Baptist calls the Israelites to conversion. This call is also for us, today. What is conversion? Conversion is to realize that we do not know what is right or wrong for us, but only God knows what is good for each one of us ... conversion also tells us that the love of God is hidden in all the events of our lives, and Advent calls us to discover this truth and cherish it as a weapon against the adversities in life.

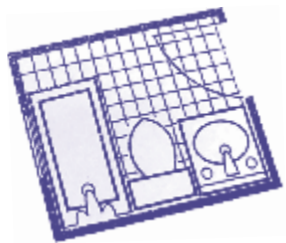
