PASTOR’S PAGE



Dear brothers and sisters, we have finally entered Ordinary Time, after this wonderful time of Christmas. Last Sunday we celebrated the Baptism of the Lord, and in today’s Gospel we again hear about Christ’s baptism. This time the heart of the Gospel is John the Baptist’s exclamation, “Behold the lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!” The interpretive key is the Second Song of the Suffering Servant, where the prophet Isaiah says God will manifest his glory in his Servant. God’s plan for him is to be not merely a servant, but a light bringing God’s salvation to the nations.

When John the Baptist sees Christ coming, he explains this salvation through reference to a specific liturgical sign: the lamb. Calling Christ a lamb evokes to a Jewish mind the Passover night. On that night, those with the blood of the lamb on their doorposts were spared the tragedy of that slaughter.

Moreover, John the Baptist says that that lamb “takes away the sin of the world.” This translation is inaccurate; the original Greek text and its Latin translation express a more profound action – that of taking sin upon himself, not just removing it.

John has understood Christ to be this lamb who alone can face mankind’s tragedy. Society always strives for progress and to create a near-perfect society, and thus to eliminate the tragedy of humanity. But there is one thing man on his own cannot eliminate: the tragedy of sin, which is separation from God.

Today’s liturgy presents Jesus to us as this humble lamb, who alone can fight the most difficult fight, that of our hearts. May the angel who passed over the houses of those Jews who had marked their doorposts with the blood of the lamb, also find the doorposts of our hearts drenched in the blood of the lamb, Christ our savior.
