PASTOR'S PAGE



Dear brothers and sisters, today we will take up a second collection for the St. Vincent House. I invite you to be generous, as over the years this ministry, born here in St. Louis, has helped many families in need of lodging or housing as their loved ones were in the hospital. I believe we should help this ministry with our generosity. Thank you for what you can do to help our brothers and sisters in need.

Today's Gospel presents to us the call of the first disciples and the Apostles. Since the Evangelists specify the location – Capernaum by the Sea of Galilee – it is important for understanding the passage.

The region is described as inhabited by people of different religions and backgrounds; it is a land of gentiles. The prophet Isaiah speaks of it as the land of darkness. Capernaum was both a crossroads and a periphery, here cultures mixed and intermingled. It was not a land of purity, of perfection, close to the Temple or organized by Jewish religion.

When Christ hears John the Baptist has been arrested, he understands his time of mission has come. He begins announcing the Gospel from this very land. This is like beginning to organize your house from the basement, a sort of storage room we never enter except to open the door and toss in things that we don't want in the house. Here it is that Christ not only begins his mission but, even calls his Apostles.

God calls men not from among the perfect, nor in an orderly place but from among those who most need it. The call to Christianity is not something we earn or deserve, but something that comes from God. It is a gift, and as such, God begins to call from Galilee, among poor people, like you and me, so that, as St. Paul reminds us: "it is in our poverty that the glory of God is manifested."
