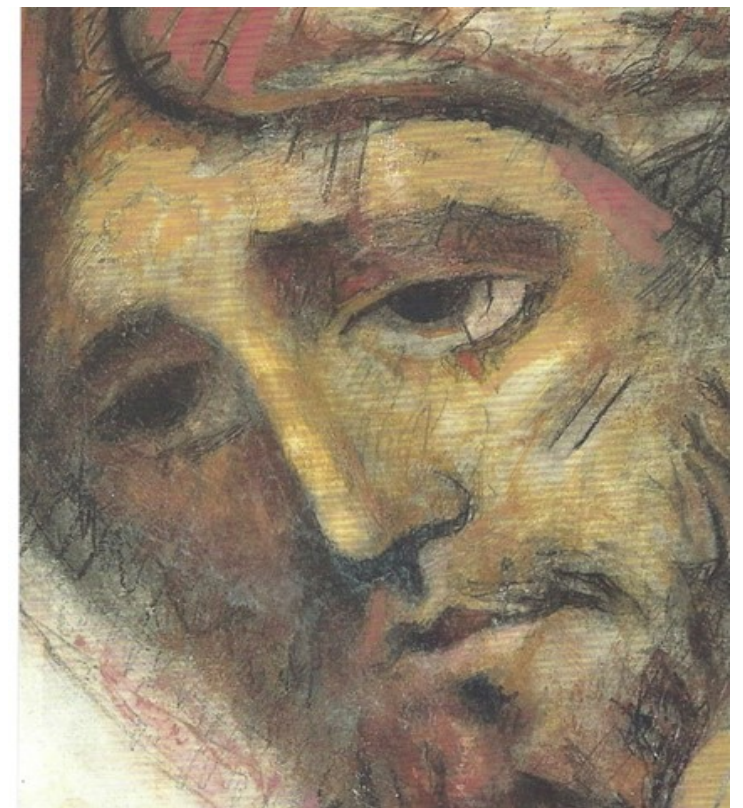

**Pastors Page Corpus Domini**



Dear Brothers and Sisters: First a note regarding the new Archdiocesan guidelines. We are now allowed 25% occupancy, which for us would mean almost 100 people in the church. However, I believe that for the moment this would still be too much for us, especially if we consider that many of our parishioners are on the vulnerable side. Since the cafeteria is available and the 10:00 a.m. Mass is always well attended (and we could accommodate more) as is the noon Mass, I decided only to increase the "units" from 20 to 22 for the Mass in the church building. Should we decide to increase seating, we will communicate this to you via Flocknote and the webpage. We will continue to broadcast the Mass. Thank you for your understanding and patience.

Today we celebrate Corpus Domini, a solemnity meant to remind us of the Eucharist's importance in our life. The Church speaks of the Eucharist as the source and summit of our Christian life.

Today's Gospel, taken from the famous Eucharistic discourse in John, reveals how Christ thinks of himself: as bread and blood to be given to us. What does this mean for us? This is indeed astonishing! Here we have a man who thinks of himself as something to be eaten. Christ presents himself not as someone needing to receive honor or be praised but essentially as a gift which is given to us, to the point of being assimilated by us as food and thus becoming part of us.

Here we must ask ourselves, what is generally more important: the food that is eaten, or the one who eats? Doubtless the one who eats, and the food is at his service. So here we understand the absurdity of God who donates himself completely so as to be assimilated by us as food. This means God thinks of himself as a gift that is going to be destroyed and assimilated by us. However, when this food that is Christ himself is assimilated by us, it has the power to transform us into what we eat, to configure us more and more into children of God.

In the Eucharist we celebrate the scandal of a God who offers himself totally to us. Christ wants to be assimilated by us. In his Sacrifice on the Cross he makes himself all to all, to serve and love us exactly as we are. Let us meditate today on this mystery and be grateful for what the Lord has done for us.
